

## HOW IT WILL WORK

Allied Waste will provide a TRASH TOTER, a 64-gallon or 35-gallon cart to each resident at **no additional charge**. Additional toters are available 64-gallon \$145 per year; 35-gallon \$120 per year and can be purchased through the Town Manager's Office.

### Improved service

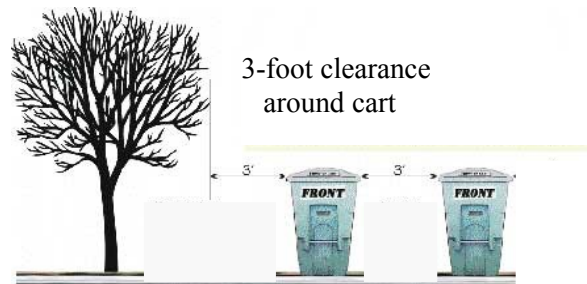
- TRASH TOTERS are convenient and easy to use.
- Large wheels make TRASH TOTERS easy to roll.
- TRASH TOTERS are strong and sturdy – little maintenance is required.
- Residents no longer need to purchase their own trash cans.
- Improves the appearance of your neighborhood by giving it a uniform look.
- Attached lids minimize animal scavenging and pests, and help control odors.

### Garbage Collection

Dispose of your bagged garbage **only** in the TRASH TOTER. Make sure the lid is closed, without packing your garbage too tightly. TRASH TOTERS are the property of Allied Waste and are assigned to your street address. On collection day, place the container as close as possible to the curb or roadside, **NOT** on the street. **Make sure the container is at least 3 feet from mailboxes, parked cars, trees, light posts and the handle and lid hinge is facing your residence. Please ensure the lid is closed to prevent damage to the 64-gallon cart(s).**



### Bulky Items

When items are too large and cannot be broken down so that they will fit into the TRASH TOTER, please call our Customer Service Team to arrange a "Special Bulk Pick-Up" at 1-800-442-9006. There

will be no additional charge for this service.

### Disposal of Excess Garbage

If you consistently have more than the Trash Toter of garbage each week, you may need to purchase a sticker for additional trash. Please call one of our Customer Service Representatives at 1-800-442-9006 to discuss purchasing a sticker. Stickers are \$5.00 each.

### What if I move?

If you move, do **NOT** take the TRASH TOTER with you. Please notify our office of your move so we may deliver a new TRASH TOTER to your new address or cancel your service should you move from our service area.

### Public Safety

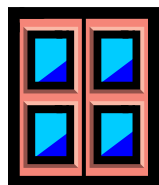
Refuse collection can be hazardous. Make sure that children stay clear of curbside refuse and collection trucks. Curbside refuse should not impede pedestrian walkways or public thoroughfares.



TRASH Toter must be at your curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled service day.



Paint containers must be empty or solidified prior to being picked up. (Use kitty litter or sand to solidify left over paint).



Glass (window panes, storm doors, etc.) must be broken up and placed in a taped box marked glass.



Liquids (i.e. thinners, oil, acids) and Medical Waste (i.e. oxygen tanks, needles) are **NOT** acceptable materials for pick up.



ALL boxes need to be broken down (3'x3'), and placed in your recycling bin or appropriate container for pick up.



If you have additional items for pick up (i.e. couch, chair, mattresses), please call our office for pick up day.

## Holiday Schedule

**This schedule applies for all residential services.**

Allied Waste and the Town observe the following Holidays:

New Year's Day

Allied Waste will NOT service Residential customers on these Holidays. We will be adjusting our service schedule by one day. For example, if the Holiday is on a Monday, the service would be as follows:

	Tuesday service will occur on WEDNESDAY
	Wednesday service will occur on THURSDAY

# Automated Solid Waste Collection

## What is automated collection?

With automated collection, each household will be provided with a TRASH Toter, a 64-gallon or 35-gallon cart with wheels.

On collection day, residents place the specially designed carts to the curbside for collection. Allied Waste will empty the cart using trucks equipped with an automated arm that will empty the cart into the truck and return the cart to its original position, without the operator leaving the cab. This collection method is much safer than traditional manual collection.
